Every fortified domain had a water source. This was essential for survival in the event of a siege. Water and life were very much intertwined with each other. A poor or vulnerable water supply could lead to a quick surrender with disastrous consequences.





Well, for our domain, this source is located within this lot. A very pretty well, built entirely of stone, just a few steps from the backdoor and with a view to the south.

Hence the name "La Source". A large buxom hedges alongside an authentic stone wall sets the separation with the neighbour.

"La vieille tour" and three beautiful chestnut trees, in the bloom of their lives, form a separation with the garden of the "Ecurie". From this part of the garden you have an exceptional view.


On the north side are a couple of car spaces, a beautiful terrace and a small library with a cellar underneath.


A swimming pool or large Jacuzzi with jet-streams is included, as indicated on the plan.


Changes can be made and plans can be "tailored" together with the future buyer.
